



This year, May Memorial (MMUUS, Syracuse) has reserved the weekend of Friday, August 26 - Sunday, August 28 for our intergenerational rental weekend at Unirondack, the UU camp and conference center in the Western Adirondacks, near Lowville, NY. ([Unirondack.org](http://Unirondack.org)). This weekend is open to members and friends of other Central NY UU congregations as well. This rental is usually September tradition, however, this year, there was a conflict from Unirondack's end and, as a result, we get to enjoy late summer at Unirondack!

The MMUUS congregation members have rented Unirondack for a community weekend for about 15 years and it has been a pleasure every year, with friendships being developed or renewed in this lovely setting. The camp has established effective COVID policies and people have been safe in their stays there. We would ask people to test themselves before they come for the weekend, and of course, to stay home if they feel sick.

Internet is available, as well as comfortable sleeping accommodations (indoor showers and bathrooms) as well as: great community spaces for gathering, recreation on the lake (swimming, boating), campfires; hiking and exploring the western Adirondacks (Stillwater Firetower and other local hikes). No dogs (or other pets) are allowed. People bring your own bedding, towels and personal items. Everyone helps with meal preparation, set-up and cleanup as they are able. Dietary needs are accommodated - please inform the coordinator ([mscross1234@gmail.com](mailto:mscross1234@gmail.com)) Weekend events are also planned by the participants..

The price is \$122 per person for the 2 night summer weekend of community and fun (includes all meals, lodging and use of the camp) **Full payment is required by August 21st** (by check, Venmo or PayPal) Some scholarship money is available to MMUUS members; please let Stephanie know if you could use some financial help to attend the weekend.
