Flower Communion



The annual meeting every year is usually preceded by a Flower Communion, a Unitarian Universalist tradition in which everyone brings a flower; they are all collected up; and then everyone takes home a flower different from the one they brought.

This tradition was begun by Rev. Norbert Capek in 1923. His story is relevant today, and needs to be remembered.

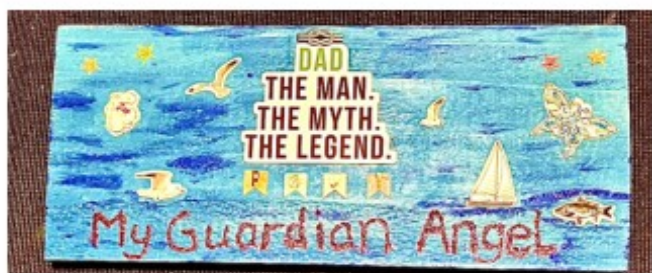
